With your consent, HealthiestYou will send an electronic copy of your visit to your primary care doctor.

Yes. HealthiestYou is available for you, your spouse, and your dependents. Dependents over 18 years of age may need to call the service center to request a visit. For dependents under 18 years old, the primary account holder (employee) must request a visit on their behalf through the app, website or by phone.





WHAT WE DO - We work closely with PAA's Physicians, Advanced Practice Providers and other clinical staff. We act as a liaison between the clinician and the facility or payer to ensure the lengthy process is as seamless/painless for our clinicians as possible.

Did you know?

CRNAs are advanced practice registered nurses who administer anesthesia and other medications. CRNAs have acquired a minimum of a doctorate degree focusing on anesthesia, have completed extensive clinical training, and have passed a certification exam approved by the National Boards of Certification and Recertification of Nurse Anesthetists.

The nurse anesthetist specialty came into existence during the American Civil War (1861 – 1865). During that time, nurses working in field hospitals were called upon to administer anesthesia (chloroform) to soldiers that were badly wounded or undergoing surgery.

PAA employs 18 full time CRNAs and has 20+ PRN that help care for PAAs patients at 4 of our Ambulatory Surgery Centers and our REACH Fertility clinic.


