Patient Safety

We go to great lengths to ensure the highest level of safety for our patients, not just during anesthesia, but throughout their entire journey with us. From the moment surgery is scheduled, we provide personalized care that spans preoperative preparation, postoperative recovery, and beyond.

Our approach begins well before the patient arrives, with a thorough review of their medical history and the development of a tailored anesthetic plan designed to maximize safety, comfort, and a swift recovery. Following surgery, our commitment continues with comprehensive postoperative care and effective pain management, ensuring a smooth transition from hospital to home and back to daily life.

We have fostered a culture of unparalleled safety, continuously monitoring outcomes, addressing patient risks, and refining processes to achieve the best possible results. Our performance consistently exceeds national benchmarks, as demonstrated by our superior scores on the National Anesthesia Clinical Outcomes Registry (NACOR), which sets the standard for 16,000 anesthesiologists nationwide.

Through these efforts, we remain steadfast in our mission to provide exceptional, research-driven, and patient-centered anesthesia care.








Quality

At PAA, we take immense pride in our commitment to exceptional patient care and uncompromising safety. Our reputation is built on evidence-based anesthetic plans and a consistent track record of positive outcomes, all driven by our steadfast dedication to quality measurement and continuous improvement.

To support these efforts, we have developed our own comprehensive quality system, PAAQS, a powerful internal resource that allows us to collect, analyze, and report data across 51 quality metrics for each patient we treat. This system provides valuable insights from every patient experience, enabling us to refine and enhance our practices.

In addition, our physicians utilize Real-Time Event Assessment (RTEA) to monitor and discuss patient outcomes as they happen. RTEA alerts are securely transmitted through a HIPAA-compliant platform to our Medical Review Committee (MRC), which diligently works to develop evidence-based pathways that further advance patient safety and quality care.



We also contribute our quality metrics to national organizations dedicated to improving anesthesia care. The American Society of Anesthesiologists' (ASA) Anesthesia Quality Institute (AQI) plays a key role in standardizing quality indicators and aggregating data from member practices nationwide. Additionally, the National Anesthesia Clinical Outcomes Registry (NACOR), the largest clinical data registry in the country, relies on contributions like ours to benchmark performance across the field. Through PAAQS, we have submitted data from over 60,000 patient cases to NACOR, allowing AQI to generate reports that compare our results to national benchmarks, driving continuous enhancements in patient safety and care.

The Patient Experience

Patient-centered care is our cornerstone, delivering better outcomes, higher satisfaction, and potential cost reductions. PAA remains committed to engaging patients throughout their surgical journey, from initial decision to complete recovery.

In partnership with our hospitals, we've developed and implemented the "We Care" handoff protocol, recognizing that patient engagement and patient-centered approaches are essential for safety and satisfaction. Many surgical facilities now incorporate patient satisfaction metrics into compensation structures for anesthesiologists and other providers.

Our **Talk to My Doc** program empowers patients through education and encourages active participation in healthcare decisions. This includes targeted initiatives like smoking cessation counseling and anemia management, all designed to promote shared decision-making.



Clinical Education

At the core of our practice are dedicated physicians and clinicians who exemplify a commitment to excellence and lifelong learning. As perpetual students of medicine, they stay at the forefront of emerging advancements, regulatory changes, and industry trends that shape our field.

Our Clinical Practice Committee (CPC) plays a pivotal role in this pursuit, continuously reviewing clinical perioperative research and literature to identify insights that impact patient outcomes both locally and nationally. These findings are shared at our monthly PAA meetings and provided in detailed reports to our CRNA partners at Novant. Equipped with the latest evidence, we refine our anesthesia protocols and strategies to maintain the highest standards of safety in surgical care.

Supporting our commitment to education, we hosted two specialized workshops in 2024: the "Trauma Anesthesia Workshop" and the "Pediatric Airway Workshop." These focused sessions provided accredited continuing education for physicians, CRNAs, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, and nurses. With 75-100 participants at each event, we created dynamic environments for professional development and collaborative learning.

Participants earned valuable continuing education credits while developing practical skills directly applicable to improving patient outcomes in these critical care areas.
